

CHEROKEE HIGH SCHOOL PARKING CONTRACT

Complete and sign the contract. Copies of your driver's license, vehicle registration, and insurance card must accompany this contract when picking up your permit in the Main Office. If you're unable to make copies, please bring all documents and the completed contract to the Main Office and we will copy the information for you.

We, the undersigned parents of _____, give permission to the above named student to use a vehicle for transportation between home and school. This permission is granted with the full understanding that transportation is provided for all students who are legally required to be transported on school buses. We, as parents, will assume responsibility for the operation of this vehicle. Furthermore, students using a vehicle for transportation between home and school must comply with the following rules and regulations set forth by the school and municipality.

1. Parking on school grounds is a privilege, not a right, and can be revoked.
2. Adhere to all school, municipal, and state parking regulations. **Seniors may only** park in white-lined spaces in the Cherokee North Main Lot and in the Cherokee North Cafeteria Lot. Parking in yellow-lined spaces, yellow no parking zones, spaces designated for staff or visitors or anywhere in the Cherokee South lots will result in discipline.
3. All vehicles parked on school grounds must be registered with the school and display the current parking permit on the rear view mirror. **PARKING PERMITS ARE NOT TRANSFERRABLE!**
4. Students must lock their vehicles. Parking permits that are stolen or lost will **NOT** be replaced.
5. All students must be licensed and covered by insurance. **THE SCHOOL IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE VEHICLE OR ITS CONTENTS.**
6. There is to be no loitering in the parking lot. Students are to park their vehicles and immediately enter the building.
7. There will be no speeding (15 miles per hour is the limit) or any form of reckless driving on school grounds.
8. Student vehicles may be subject to search if there are reasonable grounds to believe that drugs, alcohol, stolen property, or other contraband may be present in the vehicle.

9. **The Cherokee Parking Decal must be clearly visible and able to be read from the front of the vehicle when attached to the rear view mirror.** If the vehicle's rear view mirror is designed so that the hang tag would not be readily visible, the student must use tape, rubber bands, Velcro, etc., to insure that it is displayed properly.

Parking Violations

Failure to Display Cherokee Parking Decal

- 1st offense Warning
- 2nd offense Administrative Detention and loss of permit for 1 month
- 3rd offense Suspension and loss of parking permit

Parking in a Faculty Space, Visitor's Space, Fire Zone, or other illegal area (Handicap Space - Follow procedure and inform SRO upon 2nd offense)

- 1st offense 2 Administrative Detentions and loss of parking permit for 1 marking period
- 2nd offense Suspension and loss of parking permit permanently
- 3rd offense 3 day suspension

Other Discipline that affects the Senior Parking Privilege:

Lates to School

- 16 lates or 4th offense 2-day suspension and loss of parking permit permanently

Alcohol/Drug Offense (any offense incurred during Cherokee career)

- Loss of Parking Privilege

Speeding/Reckless Driving

- 1st offense Up to 3 days suspension and loss of parking permit for 45 days
- 2nd offense 3-day suspension, possible police intervention and loss of parking permit permanently

Leaving School Property

- 1st offense 1-day suspension and loss of permit for 45 days
- 2nd offense 3-day suspension and loss of parking permit permanently

- 2nd Senior Suspension of any kind** - loss of parking permit for 20 days
- 3rd Senior Suspension of any kind** - loss of parking permit permanently

Student/Parent Copy of Rules & Regulations

1. Parking on school grounds is a privilege, not a right, and can be revoked.
2. Adhere to all school, municipal, and state parking regulations. Seniors may only park in white-lined spaces in the Cherokee North Main Lot and in the Cherokee North Cafeteria Lot. Parking in yellow-lined spaces, yellow no parking zones, spaces designated for staff or visitors, or anywhere in the Cherokee South lots will result in discipline.
3. All vehicles parked on school grounds must be registered with the school and display the current parking permit on the rear view mirror. **PARKING PERMITS ARE NOT TRANSFERRABLE!**

Parking Violations

Failure to Display Cherokee Parking Decal

- 1st offense Warning
- 2nd offense Administrative Detention and loss of permit for 1 month
- 3rd offense Suspension and loss of parking permit

Parking in a Faculty Space, Visitor's Space, Fire Zone, or other illegal area (Handicap Space - Follow procedure and inform SRO upon 2nd offense)

- 1st offense 2 Administrative Detentions and loss of parking permit for 1 marking period
- 2nd offense Suspension and loss of parking permit permanently
- 3rd offense 3 day suspension

Other Discipline that affects the Senior Parking Privilege:

Lates to School

16 lates or 4th offense 2-day suspension and loss of parking permit permanently

Alcohol/Drug Offense (any offense incurred during Cherokee career)

Loss of Parking Privilege

Speeding/Reckless Driving

- 1st offense Up to 3 days suspension and loss of parking permit for 45 days
- 2nd offense 3-day suspension, possible police intervention and loss of parking permit permanently

Leaving School Property

1st offense 1-day suspension and loss of permit for 45 days

2nd offense 3-day suspension and loss of parking permit permanently

2nd Senior Suspension of any kind - loss of parking permit for 20 days

3rd Senior Suspension of any kind - loss of parking permit permanently
