
First Website for Web Design in Wix

Create an account:

1. Go to <https://www.wix.com/>
2. Click the *Sign In* button in the upper, right-hand side of the page.
3. On the next page, click *Sign Up*
4. You will be brought to the page to create an account.
 - a. Use your Lenape email address to sign up.
 - b. Record your password someplace safe!

Create a website:

1. On the next screen, click the *Create Your Website*.
2. On the next screen, click *Other*
3. Click *Start with Wix Editor* on the next page.
4. Click *Blank Templates* and then *Start from Scratch*
5. The site is now being built. This could take a minute or so to be completed.
6. Click the *Save* button and name your site
 - a. Name the site your full name

Creation of the pages:

1. Click on the *Pages* button in the header of the page.
2. Click the *Add Page* button and then choose *Page*. Add the following four pages to your site. Drag the pages if needed so that they are in the order listed.
 - i. Rename Home to My Favorites
 - ii. Facts about me
 - iii. Pictures of me
 - iv. Topic of your choice – Choose something that is important to you. That could be your family, your friends, a certain sport or hobby you are involved in, your church, etc. You can use any topic you want...as long as it is school appropriate!

Creation of the header: Note – This header will be applied to every page.

1. Click on the *Pages* button and go back to *Home*
2. Format the header for the site.
 - a. Change the background (color or image)
 - b. Add text to the header. Format this text.

Creation of the menu:

1. While still on the *My Favorites* page, add a menu to the site. *Add* button and then *Menu*. Choose a menu that you like but also customize it as well.
2. Format the menu to something you like and that goes with the header you created above.
3. Once the menu is how you want it to look, click on it, navigate to box of tools on the right-hand side of the page, and the click on *Show on All Pages*. Now the menu will appear on all the pages you create.
