
What are your favorites?

1. Open PowerPoint and start a Blank Presentation.
2. Save this presentation on your H: drive.
 - a. Create a folder called Web Design.
 - b. Start a new folder under this folder called First Website.
 - c. Name this presentation My Favorites Collage.

This project will only be ONE slide in PowerPoint!

3. Select the textboxes that are automatically on the first slide and delete them.
4. Think about what two or three colors you want to use for this project.
5. Insert a background for this slide. Design=>Format Background
6. Insert the words "My Favorites" using WordArt. Insert=>WordArt
 - a. Change the font style, size, text fill, and text outline. You may also want to add some text effects to make the words stand out.
7. You now need to include at least 8 of your favorites on this slide. Below is a list to get you thinking but you are not limited to these topics. Be creative and think of some on your own. This is your opportunity to introduce yourself to me!

8. Once you determine your topics, label them on the slide using WordArt.
 - a. Remember to change the WordArt to something different from the default.
 - b. Use copy and paste if you want all the labels to look the same.
9. Now, insert a picture for each favorite.
 - a. You may not use words to show what your favorite is, only pictures.
 - b. Copy and paste these pictures from the Internet.
 - c. Once you have inserted the picture, resize it to an appropriate size for the project.
 - d. Also, add something to the picture to make it look different from the original picture.
 - e. Maybe add a border, add a picture effect, change the color scheme, etc.
 - f. All of these options can be found under the Format tab when you have the picture selected.
 - g. If you want the same changes to be on every single picture, use the Format Painter.
