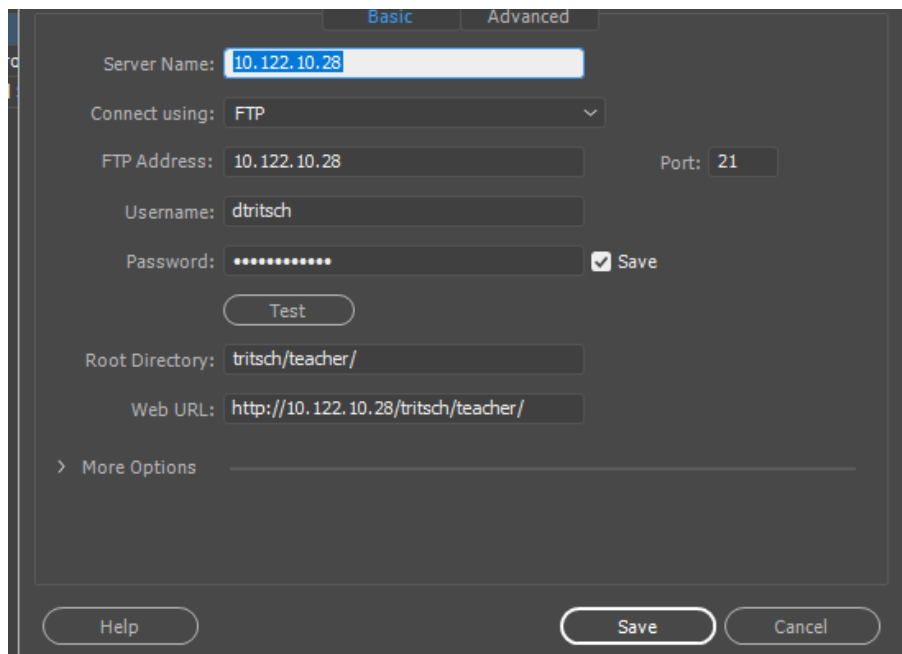


## Teacher Server Access in Dreamweaver

Connecting:

1. Site—Manage Site
2. Select Site by double clicking or set-up when creating root folder
3. Click Servers
4. Fill in the following information:
  - Server Name: 10.122.10.28
  - Connect Using: FTP
  - FTP Address: 10.122.10.28
  - Username: your username or students
  - Password: your password or students
  - Root Directory: teachername/teacher/ OR teachername/studentid#
  - Web Url
    - For Teacher: <http://10.122.10.28/teachername/teacher>
    - For Student: <http://10.122.10.28/teachername/studentid#>
5. Save



To get the site up on the server:

1. Go to your files palette, select your site
2. Click the connect to remote server button
3. Then click the arrow pointing up.

To get to the site online:

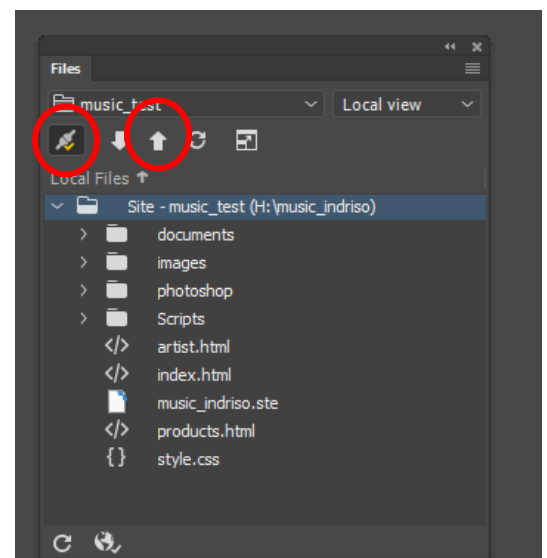
Put in web url:

For Student:

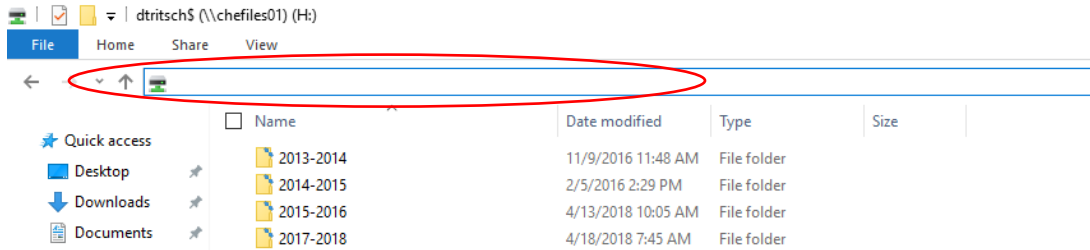

To access this via File Explorer:

Open File Explorer and delete everything at the top (shown in red below) and put the following address [\\10.122.10.28\web\\$](http://10.122.10.28/web$)

That will allow you to access all of your students site folders and delete as needed
